Present Simple – 3rd Person Singular (Positive)

There are two forms for the simple present tense; one ends with -s and the other doesn't.

Subject	Verb Form	Example
1	simple form	l sing
You	simple form	You sing
Не	simple form + S	He sings
She	simple form + S	She sings
lt	simple form + S	It sings

Most vebs are formed by adding **-S**. However, with some verbs, you need to add **-ES** or **-IES**. Here are the rules:

Verb ends with	How to make	Example
S	Add -ES	He pass es
z	Add -ES	She waltz es
sh	Add -ES	She wish es
ch	Add -ES	He watch es
x	Add -ES	She mix es
consonant + y	Change Y to I , then add - ES	It fl ies
vowel + y	Add - S	He play s
all other verbs	Add -S	He sing s

Present Simple – Third Person Singular (Negative)

When forming negatives use: **DON'T** or **DOESN'T**.

However, the main verb stays in the simple form – WITHOUT s.

For example:

- I <u>like</u> apples. <u>I don't like</u> oranges.
- She lives in Fujairah. She doesn't live in Dubai.
- My father works at a bank. He doesn't work at a school.
- Basma studies English. She doesn't study Arabic.

Present Simple – Third Person Singular (Questions)

When forming questions use: **<u>DO</u>** or **<u>DOES</u>**.

The main verb again stays in the simple form - **WITHOUT s**.

For example:

- **<u>Do</u>** you <u>like</u> oranges?
- Does she live in Dubai?
- **Does** your father work at a school?
- **Does** Basma **study** Arabic?
